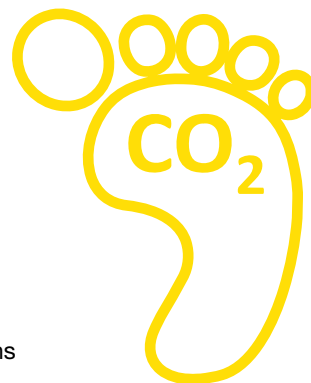

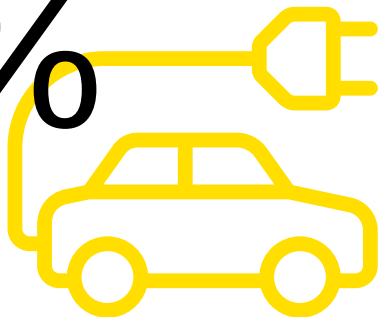

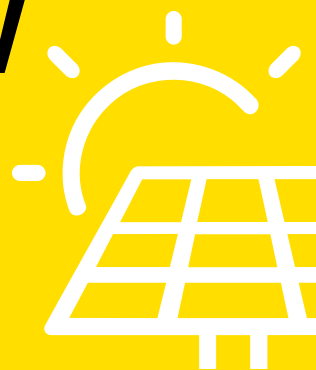

2.2 Headline targets

The VEGA group of companies is committed to reaching Greenhouse Gas (GHG) neutrality in Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 2033.

Achieving compliance with relevant legislation including the EU Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD), starting with an in-depth analysis of 2024 performance across a wide range of environmental, social and governance areas.

The UK Climate Change Act (2008) commits to achieving net zero by 2059 by reducing GHG emissions by at least 100% of 1990 levels by 2050.

Protecting the natural world

Our selected Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) for nature are:



3.1 Sustainable water management

VEGA UK headquarters is located on a business estate in rural Sussex with a wildlife-rich pond that was designed to collect and naturally filter rain and run off water.

Climate change is increasing deluge rainfall and the pond is an adaptation response, which diverts surface water during times of heavy rain away from surface water drains, reducing pressure on local water treatment facilities.

3.2 Supporting biodiversity

A protected native woodland borders the headquarters site and the team are always looking for ways to support and enhance the natural environment.

To support this work, a qualified ecologist completed a baseline biodiversity assessment of the grounds and landscape around the HQ building.

102 species were recorded and a plan has been developed to improve the quality of habitats around the building to support biodiversity.

3.3 VEGA products helping protect the environment

VEGA’s sensor technology monitors pollution incidents particularly in the water and waste management industries. VEGA UK is a strategic partner to major water companies and a regular supplier to the Environment Agency, SEPA and NRW for flood, pollution, sewer and effluent monitoring.



Commissioning a VEGABAR 80 Series pressure transmitter for sludge digester level measurement, supporting reliable operation and efficient wastewater treatment.



Installation of a VEGAPULS C21 radar level transmitter for spill discharge monitoring, supporting reliable measurement and improved visibility of wastewater network activity.

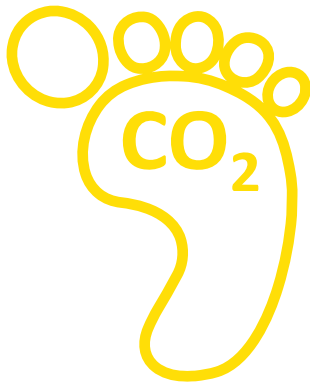
Reducing our environmental impact

Our selected Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) for impact are:



Impact

4.1 Reducing greenhouse gas emissions



The VEGA group’s headline environmental target is to be Greenhouse Gas neutral in Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 2033.

In 2025, VEGA UK reduced its Scope 1 and 2 CO₂e emissions by 67% through a combination of measures including improved data monitoring, energy efficiency, fleet electrification, changing electricity purchasing to 100% renewable contracts and installation of on-site renewable energy generation.

VEGA UK also collects data on Scope 3 business travel

and commuting. VEGA Group manufacturing facilities for products sold by VEGA UK also collect data on Scope 3 Products and Services. In 2025 VEGA UK reduced business travel emissions by 20% through a reduction in hotel stays and 79% reduction in km travelled in hired vehicles.

4.2 Water consumption



A 29% reduction in building water consumption was achieved in 2025 compared to the previous year. The UK HQ building already has water efficient fixtures and equipment. The water consumption reduction has been achieved mainly through reducing watering the landscaping.



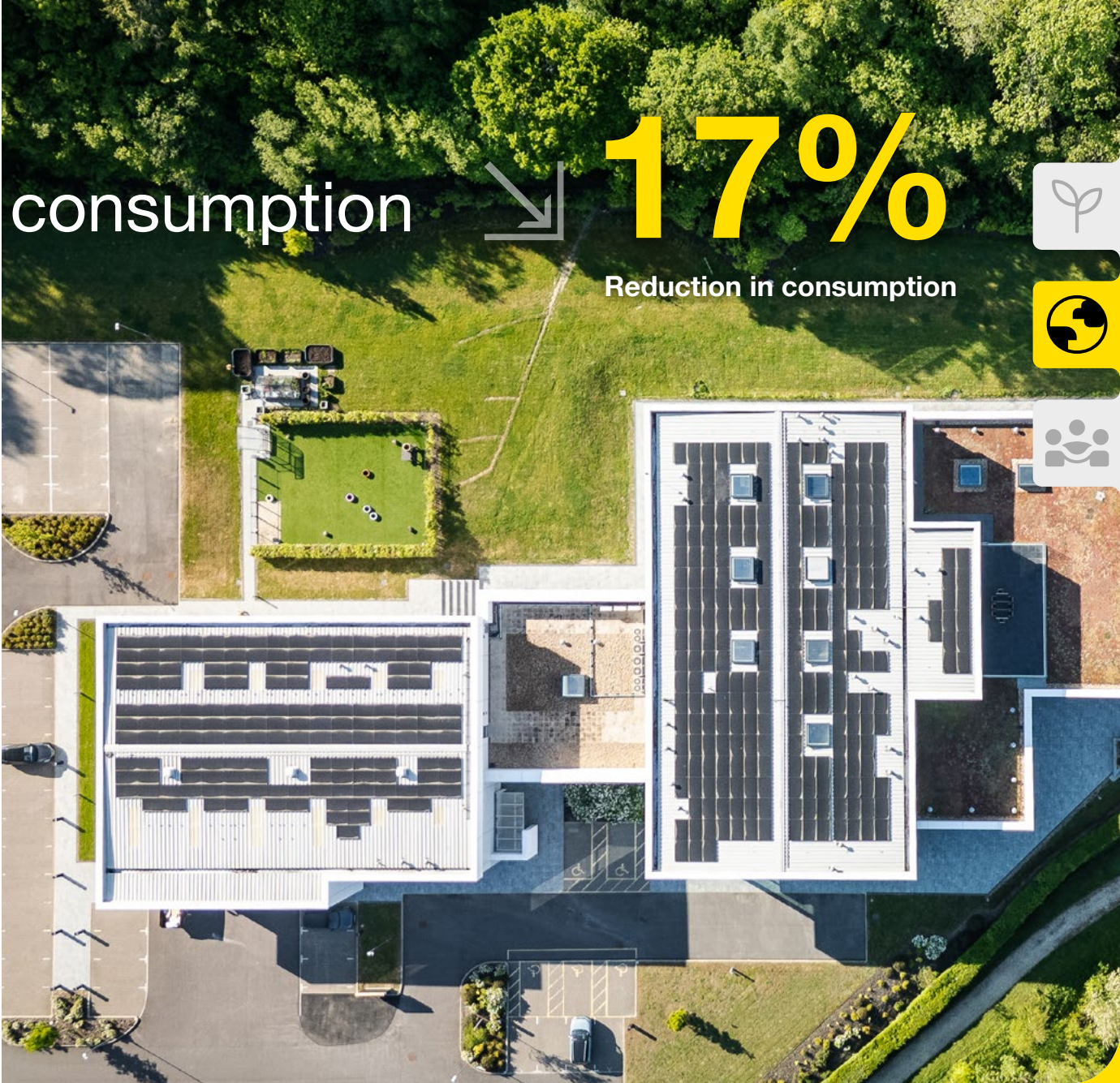
Impact

4.3 Building energy consumption

VEGA UK’s fully electric HQ building was completed in 2020 and is highly energy efficient. In 2025, VEGA UK reduced building energy consumption by 17% compared to the previous year. 2025 was the first full year of operation of the large solar PV installation on VEGA UK’s roof, with the addition of 300kW of battery capacity. This has reduced building energy use significantly.

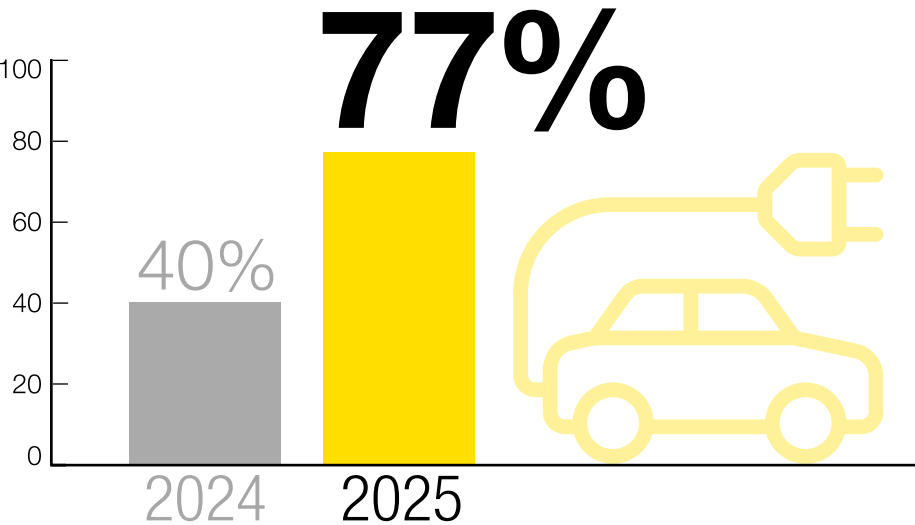

4.4 Fleet electrification

77% of VEGA UK’s fleet is now electric, up from 40% in 2024. All fleet vehicles are replaced with electric when leases are renewed.

At the same time, there has been 81% reduction in volume of diesel used in fleet vehicles.

4.5 Reducing waste

A waste partnership was formed with Recorra, following the retendering of the waste management contract, enabling VEGA to access weighed waste data. In 2025, 63% of waste was recycled. Recorra also provided internal staff training on best practice for reducing waste and improving recycling. Food waste has been removed from general waste and now composted on-site, which also meets the latest regulations.

4.6 Built to last

Merchandise and exhibition materials

Our branded merchandise is used across exhibitions, customer visits, training sessions and meetings, so we focus on practical, reusable items — multitools, pen knives, screwdrivers, torches, measuring tools and reusable bottles — rather than throwaway novelty products.

The same approach applies to our exhibition stand. Our OCTANORM framed stand has been in use since 2019 across multiple exhibition seasons, reducing waste from short-term builds. We've also reused our carpet rather than replacing flooring after each show, cutting unnecessary waste and making better use of existing materials.

5.1 Instruments for change partnership

In 2025 VEGA UK launched a partnership project with Trees for the Future (TREES) to make a donation from VEGA BASIC, PRO and AIR device and accessory sold. 5.2 Sustainability grants for employees

In 2024, VEGA UK launched a small grants project encourage employees to take positive sustainability action at home. In 2025 the 24 grants awarded grants helped to fund dehumidifiers, home solar panels, water butts, heated airers, EV charging points, bird feeding stations, energy efficient lights and food growing equipment.

5.3 Supporting good causes

In 2025, VEGA contributed £12,000 to good causes, supporting charities, local communities and team-led fundraising activities throughout the year.

Highlights included a customer team-building day at West Country Water Park for WaterAid UK, Christmas Jumper Day for Chestnut Tree House Hospice, and a skydive for Helen Rollason Cancer Charity — showing how colleagues, customers and partners can create impact beyond day-to-day work.

5.4 Employee well-being sessions

Throughout 2025, we supported employee well-being with on-site massage sessions every other month. These 20-minute appointments, delivered by a qualified sports massage therapist, let colleagues step away from their desks to address soft tissue aches, posture, circulation and stress.

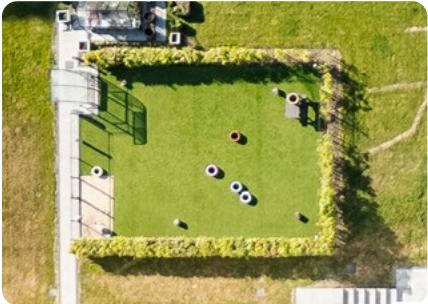
In October, we expanded this into a well-being day, adding chiropractic sessions — posture checks, spine checks and gait scans — giving colleagues practical insight into their physical health and long-term adjustments.



5.5 Pets at work

VEGA UK supports a dog-friendly workplace, allowing employees to bring their dogs into the office where suitable. A dedicated outside exercise area gives dogs space to stretch their legs during the day, while helping colleagues balance work with the practicalities of pet ownership.
